Recap

- The IO8/A8: “Work insertion of refugees and asylum seekers; Guidelines for operators in the field” research report presented:

A set of guidelines that presented a wide number of good practices that can be useful tools for operators working for the inclusion of political refugees and asylum seekers.

The Guidelines aim to present a wide number of good practices that could be useful tools for operators working for the inclusion of political refugees and asylum seekers. Some of them have emerged thanks to the research carried out during the development of this project and some others are the result of desk research and interviews with people already active in this working field.



For the purposes of collecting data, all partners have carried out desk research, using online resources and their own professional experiences, in order to gather most of the good practices existing at national level.

This offers to our target group a complete overview of positive actions performed for the reception of migrants in different countries.

The Guidelines are structured into two sections:

- The first (1) is a detailed index of the inserted practices, their use modality, etc.
- The second (2) is a collection/repertoire of sixty good practices for the practitioner who works with migrants put in order and classified according macro-areas of intervention.
- A “Definitions” section was also inserted above these, as those might have different legal consequences and legal obligations in different countries, which in turn also have psychological, social, economic and other impacts that are relevant to professionals.



Section 1: Index of practices

In order to give a clear overview of the practices we found, we have divided them in four different categories according to their main objectives:

- Empowerment techniques
- Procedures of recognition of the titles and of the professional qualifications
- Techniques of guidance and socio-employment insertion
- Access to information

Section 2: Good practices presentation

All partners provided examples of ‘good practices’ with particular regard to:

(a) Programmes available to migrants on regional/ national level that are designed to promote social and work inclusion.

(b) Policies and practices, including mechanisms to assess and address the challenges encountered, in the implementation of activities aiming at migrants’ social and professional integration.

(c) Training and educational programmes provided to adult educators and staff involved on migrants’ education/ training/ administration/ legal support on regional/ national level. intercultural competences and work inclusion, amongst others.



Transnational Meeting in Rethymno-Crete

During the final project meeting in Rethymno (GR) the testing activities and Final version of IO5, IO6, IO7 and IO8 were presented. Partners discussed all the activities that are carried out so far for the project dissemination and promotion. As our project is now reaching its end, we made sure that all tasks are completed as scheduled and discussed any pending responsibilities. Our last important task is the organisation of the project's final conference, which will take place in each partner country by the 10th of August 2019.
